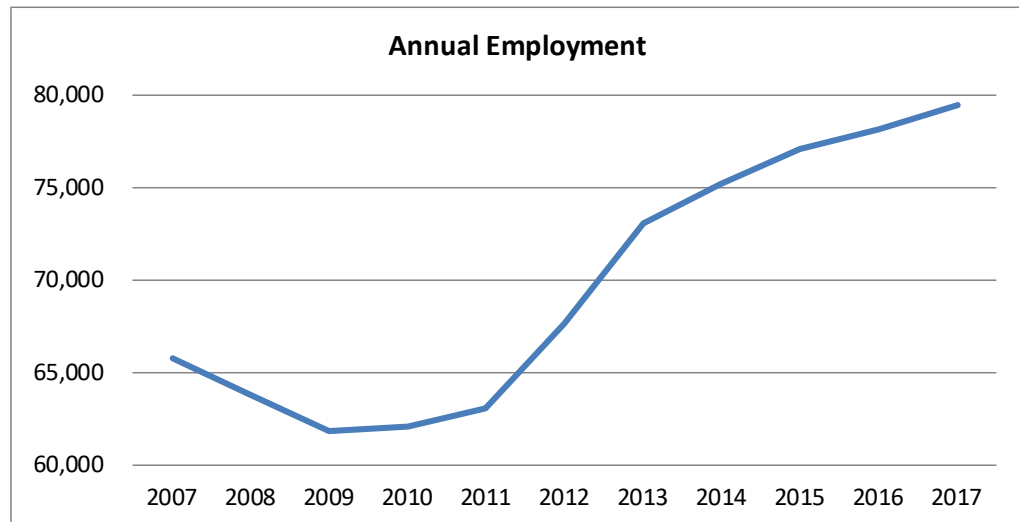

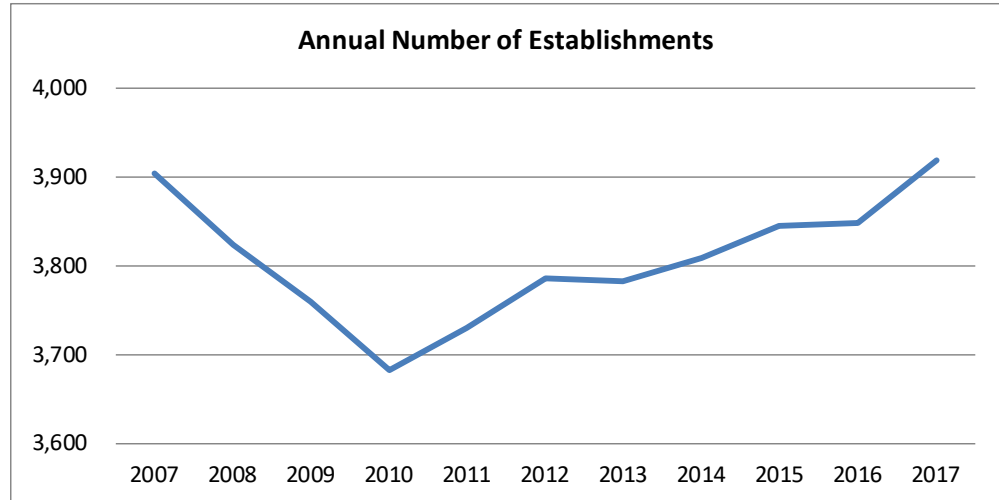

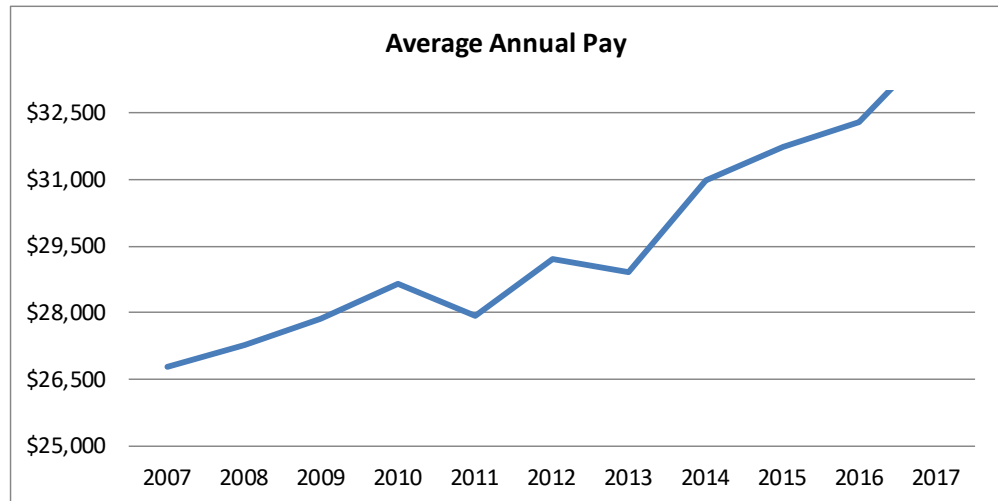

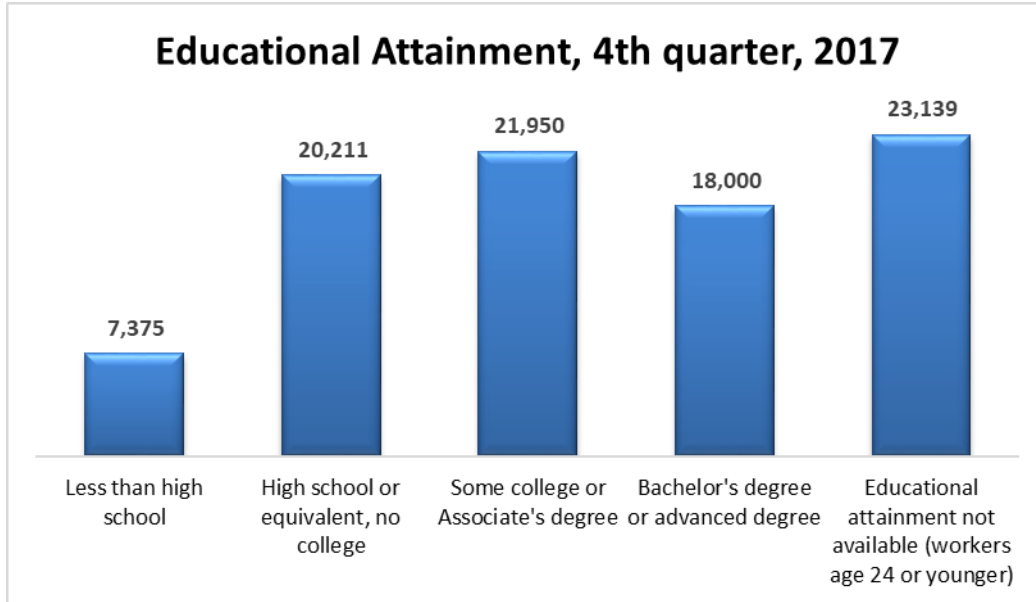

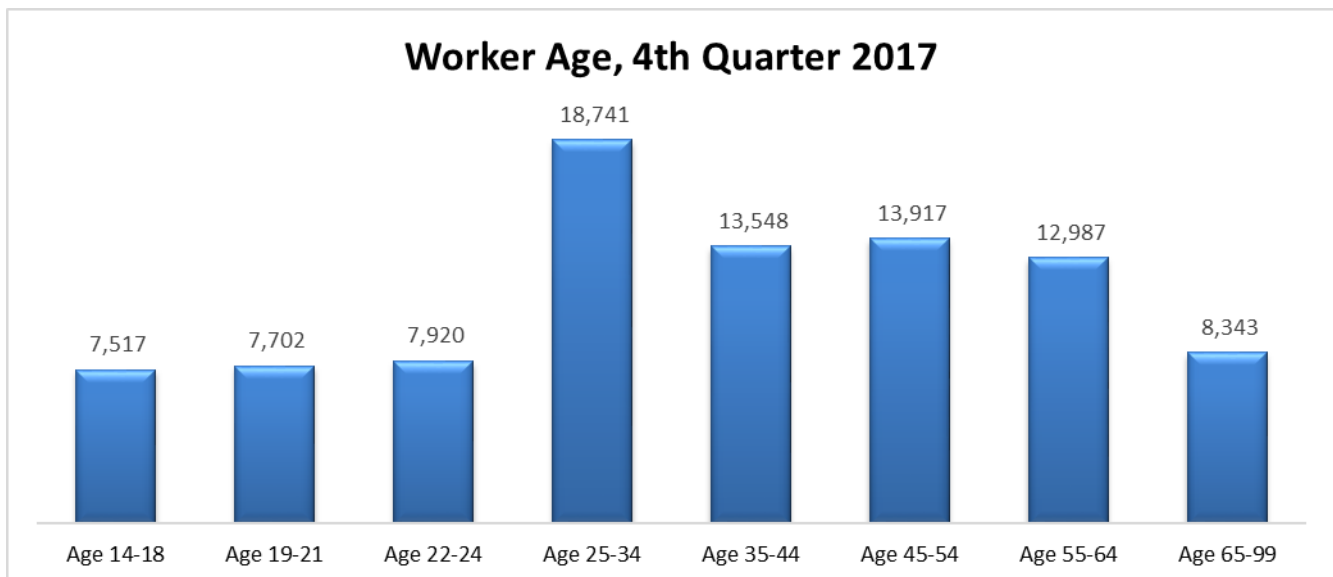

### Worker Age

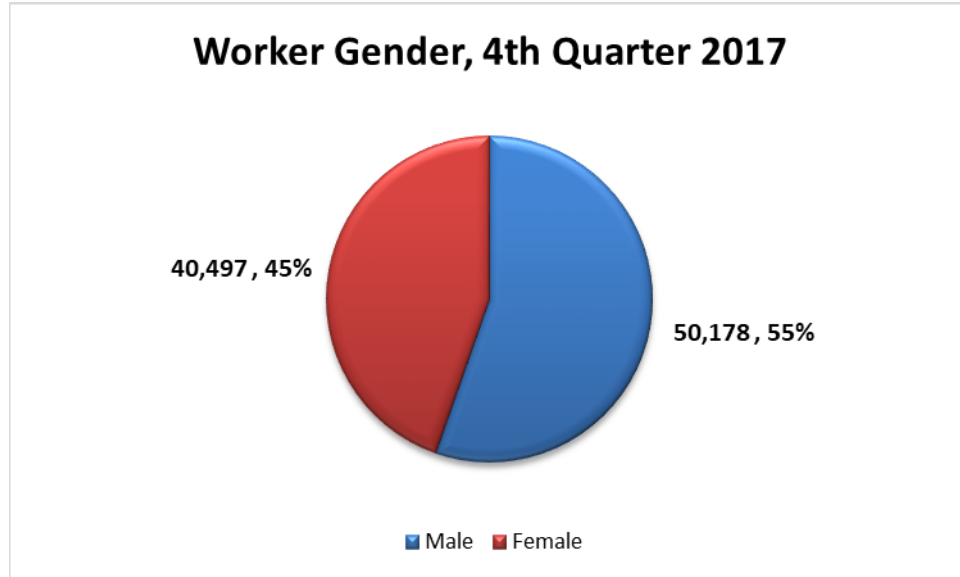
