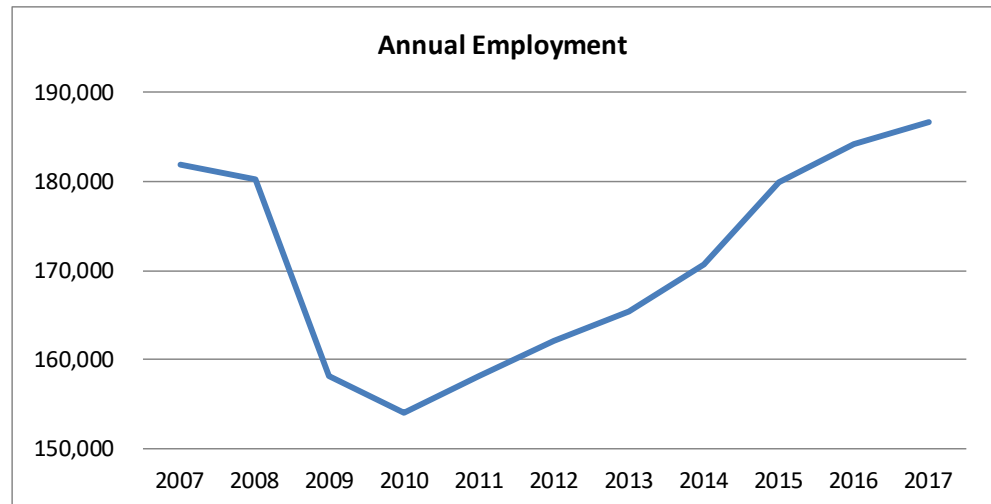

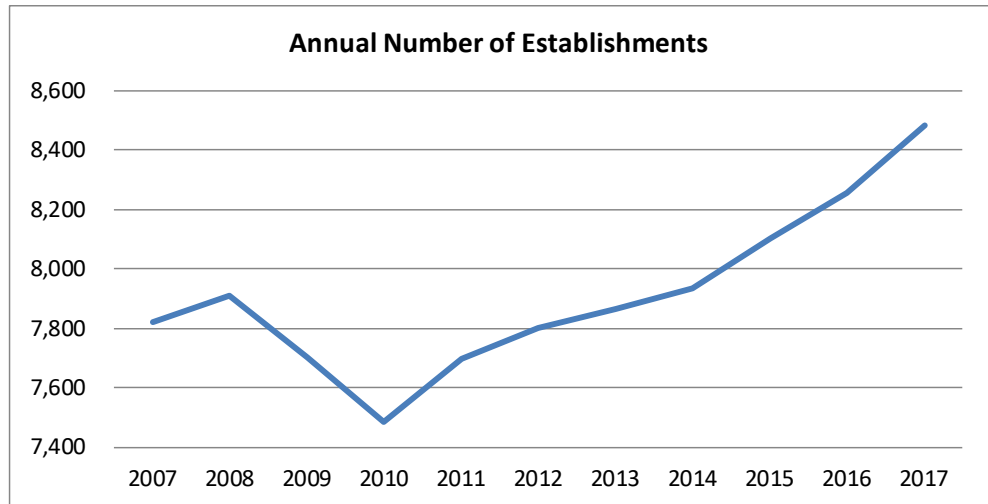

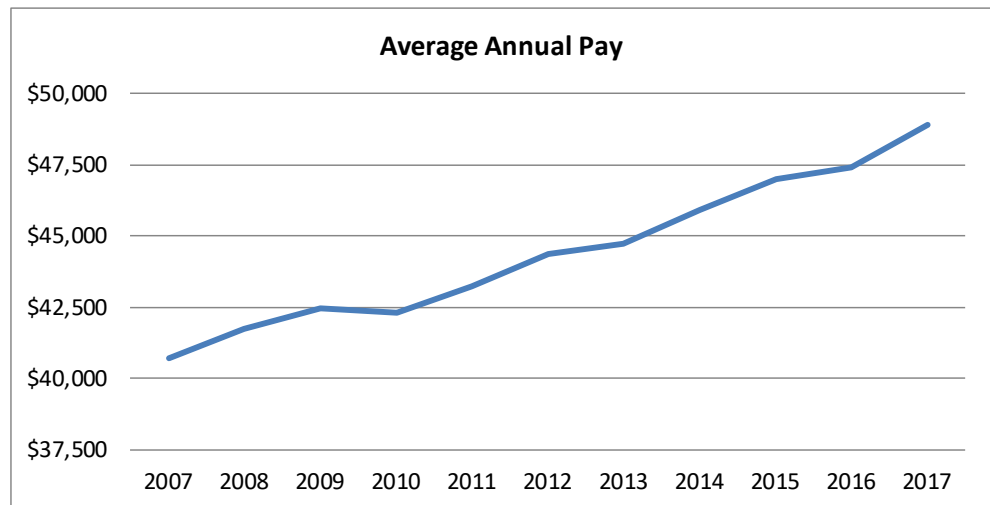

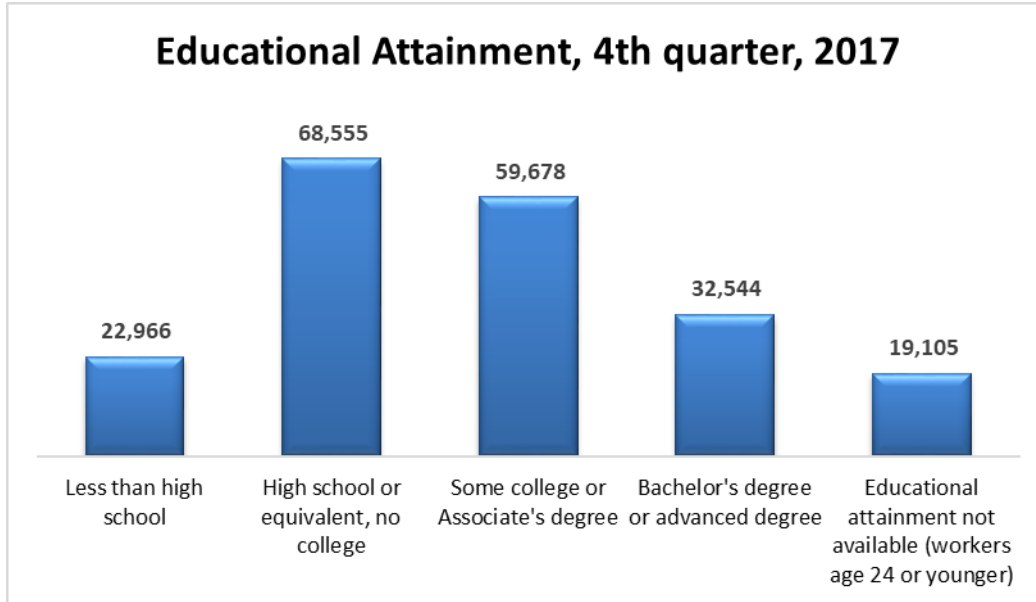

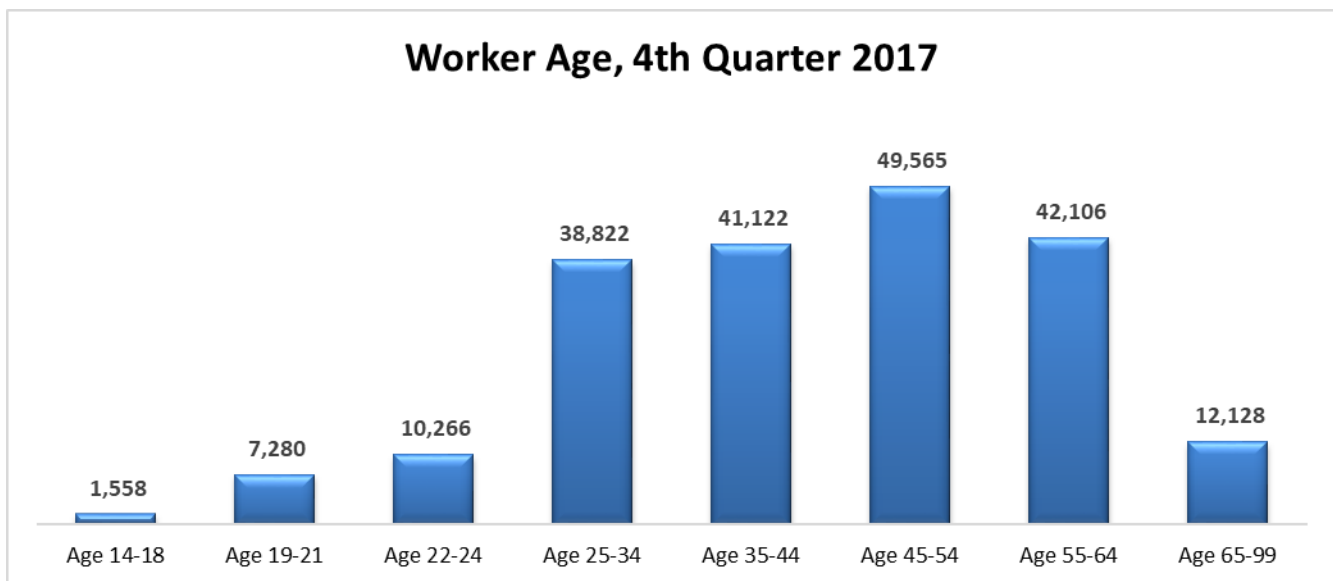

Worker Age

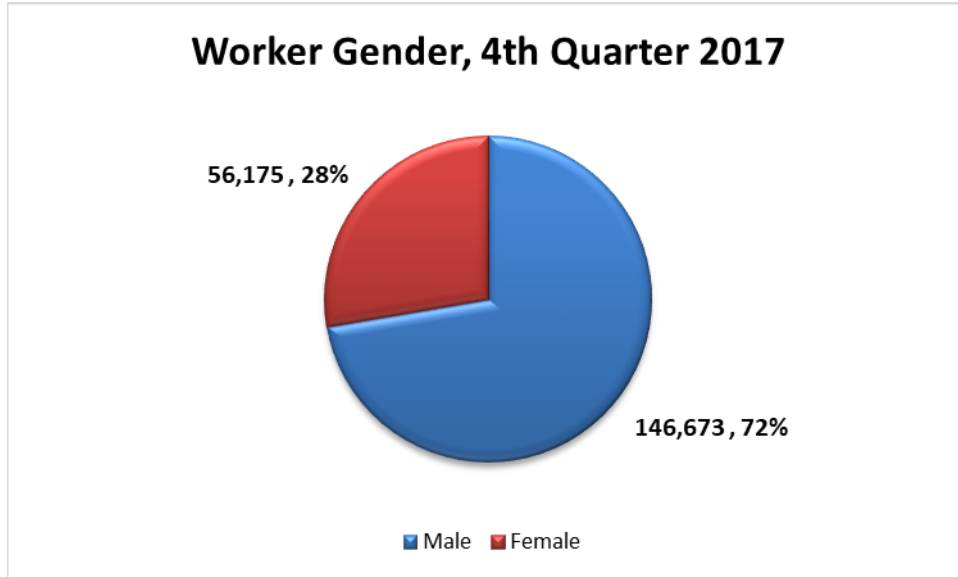
